Introduction

Glendale Elementary School is a school rich in diversity and offers an array of programming options and services. This includes both English Language Instruction and Dual-Language Immersion Instruction strands, a Vision Impaired and Deaf/Hard of Hearing Programming, and a Community Learning Center. Drawing its students from multiple neighborhoods, Glendale staff seek to meet the needs of the whole child through attention to academic and social-emotional learning. Staff are organized in teams to plan and problem solve together. Working together with the families it serves, Glendale Elementary School's goal is to support student growth which enables them to develop the foundation on their way to college, career and community.



Strengths

Our school's core beliefs include (a) staff collaboration makes our school strong, (b) we share responsibility for all students, and (c) student engagement is the key to learning. These beliefs drive all of our decisions.

Progress

In the last years we have been working on staff team development, focusing instruction based on standards, and integrating social-emotional skills into daily learning experiences. Our student proficiency rates, as measured by the Measures of Academic Progress exam, have increased 10% since 2013-14! We continue to focus on teaching the whole child to be a productive community member and citizen.

Areas for Growth

Glendale Elementary's staff, working through instructional teacher teams, will focus its improvement efforts for the coming year in three areas: (1) improving the quality of lessons that students experience daily, (2) improving the coordination of classroom supports through co-planning and co-teaching, and (3) developing more equitable strategies to engage the families it serves.

Vision Connection

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence and community connection. Through these skills and abilities, our students will graduate college, career and community ready.










Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate


Each bar shows the percent of students meeting the relevant metric overall and for the focus groups the school selected on their School Improvement Plan (SIP, when applicable).
